

Instructions for the Top Fill Hummingbird Feeders

Models 120TF, 121TF and 122TF

1. Check to make sure the base compartments are securely tightened
2. Push container into base to close ports to prevent leakage
3. Unscrew to cap to fill with nectar Screw cap back on securely to form an airtight seal.
 - a. 121TF & 122TF Feeders please note: if the cap does not fit securely on to the feeder and you see a gap between the cap and the feeder, the seal may be the issue. Please contact our Consumer Care Department at 1.800.800.1819 or consumers@woodstream.com for a new outer ring for your feeder.
 - b. To replace the outer ring, push firmly on the center of the cap to pop out the middle. Replace with new outer ring.
4. We recommend keeping the feeder in the closed position until you get to the spot where you want to hang it.
5. To open nectar reservoir - hold base with one hand and pull up on the container with the other to open ports for feeding.
6. Your feeder is now ready.

Recommended Cleaning Care for Hummingbird Feeders

Hummingbird feeders really need to be cleaned every week. Use hot water and a **bottle brush** , but do not use any soap or detergent.

The **Perky-Pet™ cleaning mop** is specially designed for this purpose and very convenient to use. A bleach solution can also be used as long as it is diluted and then rinsed completely.
