WHAT IT IS: Tomato & Vegetable Insect Killer is a specially formulated combination of insecticidal soap and botanical pyrethrins that kills insects on contact yet is gentle on plants.

WHAT IT KILLS: Aphids, Asparagus beetles, Bean beetles, cabbage loopers, Caterpillars, Colorado potato beetles, Cucumber beetles, Diamond-backed moth, Flea beetles, Imported cabbageworm, Leafhoppers, Plant bugs, Tomato hornworm and Whiteflies.

WHERE TO USE IT: Asparagus, Beans, Broccoli, Brussels sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Cucumbers, Eggplant, Herbs, Kale, Lettuce, Peppers, Potatoes, Squash and Tomatoes.

HOW TO USE IT: Shake Well. Use at first sighting of insects. Thoroughly moisten all plant surfaces where insects are feeding or resting. Apply every 7 to 10 days when insets are present or as needed to prevent damage. **CAN BE USED UP TO THE DAY OF HARVEST.**

USE WITH CAUTION on tender new foliage.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

FIRST AID
